

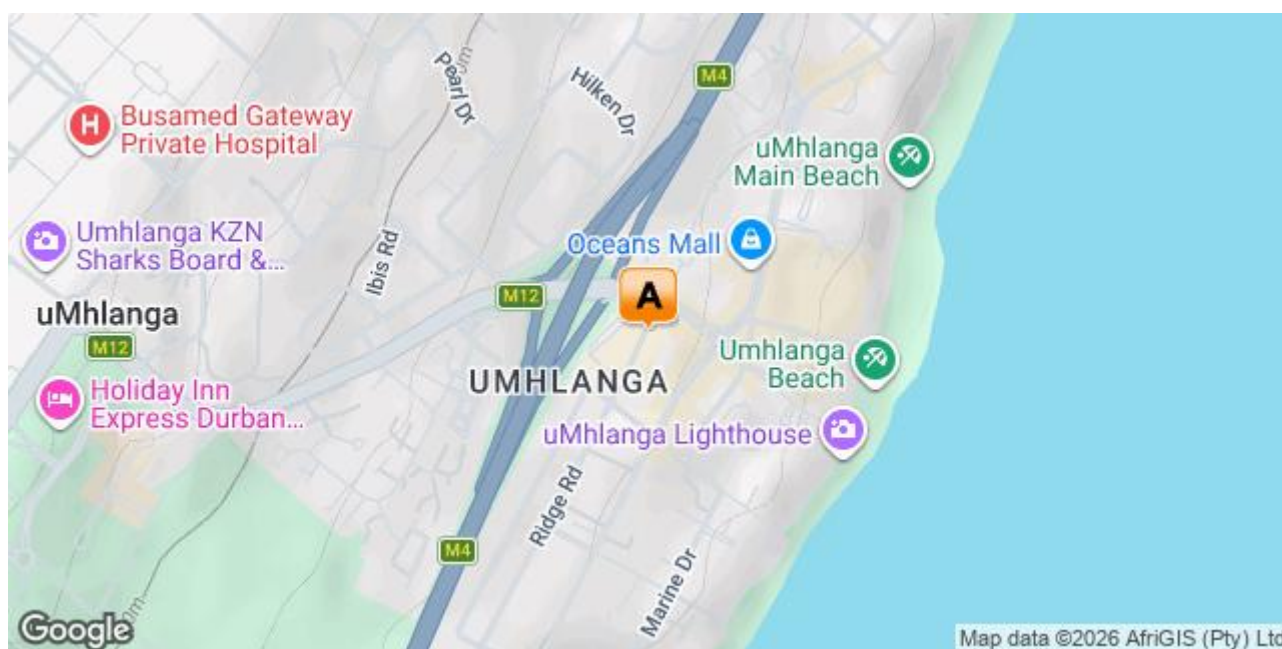

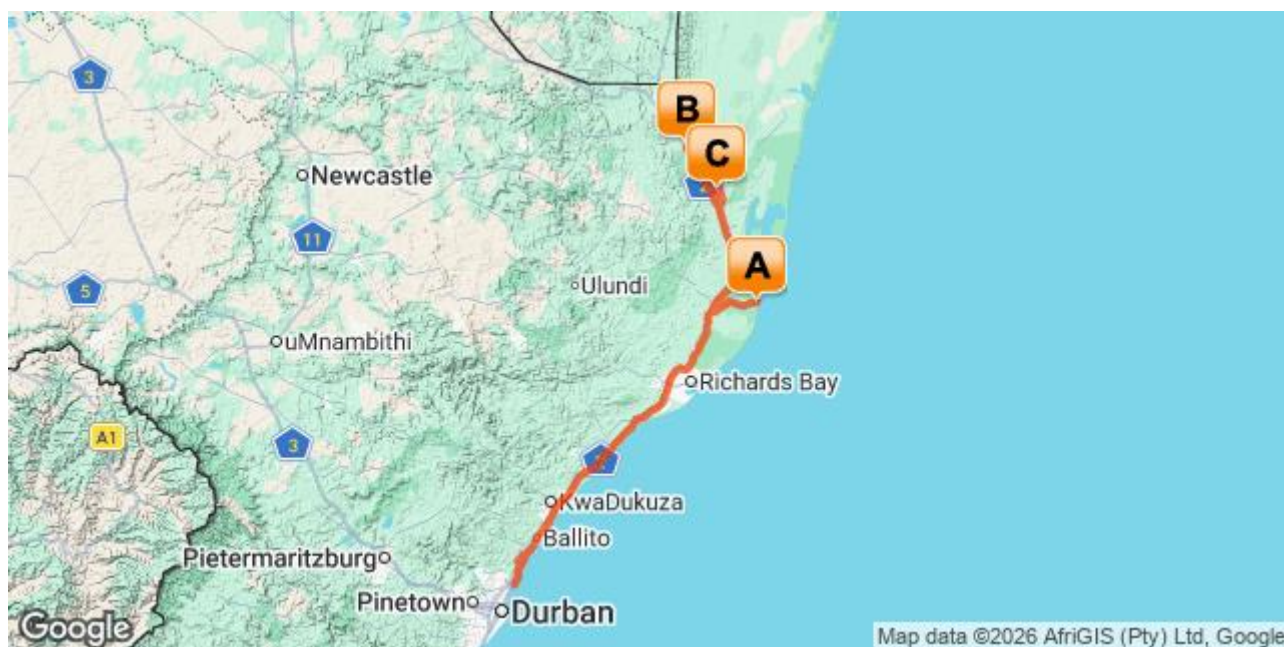

Day 1: Elephant Lake Hotel, St Lucia (Sun, 1 August 2027)

Day Itinerary

After breakfast and check-out, there will be the mornings closing ceremony and lunch. Then you will be picked up at the hotel and transferred to St. Lucia. Here, you will stay at Elephant Lake Hotel with walking distance to shops and restaurants.

Watch out for hippos in the streets – this is a truly unique experience!

Between 18:00 and 20:00, you may spot the iconic hippos emerging from the river and passing through Elephant Lake Hotel, where you are staying, before continuing into the streets on their way to the park to graze overnight, returning to the water early in the morning.

Overnight: Elephant Lake Hotel

The Elephant Lake Hotel is located on the shores of the St Lucia Estuary in the town of St Lucia, Kwa Zulu Natal, within the iSimangaliso Wetland Park, South Africa's first World Heritage Site. St Lucia is 25km from the main N2 route between Durban and Swaziland, 75 km South from Hluhluwe town and 80 km North of Richards Bay.

The Hotel has a three-star grading and boasts with 56 upmarket, en-suite, air-conditioned rooms, all sharing a westerly view across the St Lucia Estuary. All rooms are equipped with DSTV, tea/coffee making facilities, wall safes, hair dryer and full range of bathroom amenities. The Hotel has two levels. The ground level has 25 rooms, all with a private patio leading out to a sparkling pool, an upmarket restaurant, leading out to the pool patio, the Hotel lounge and Reception area. 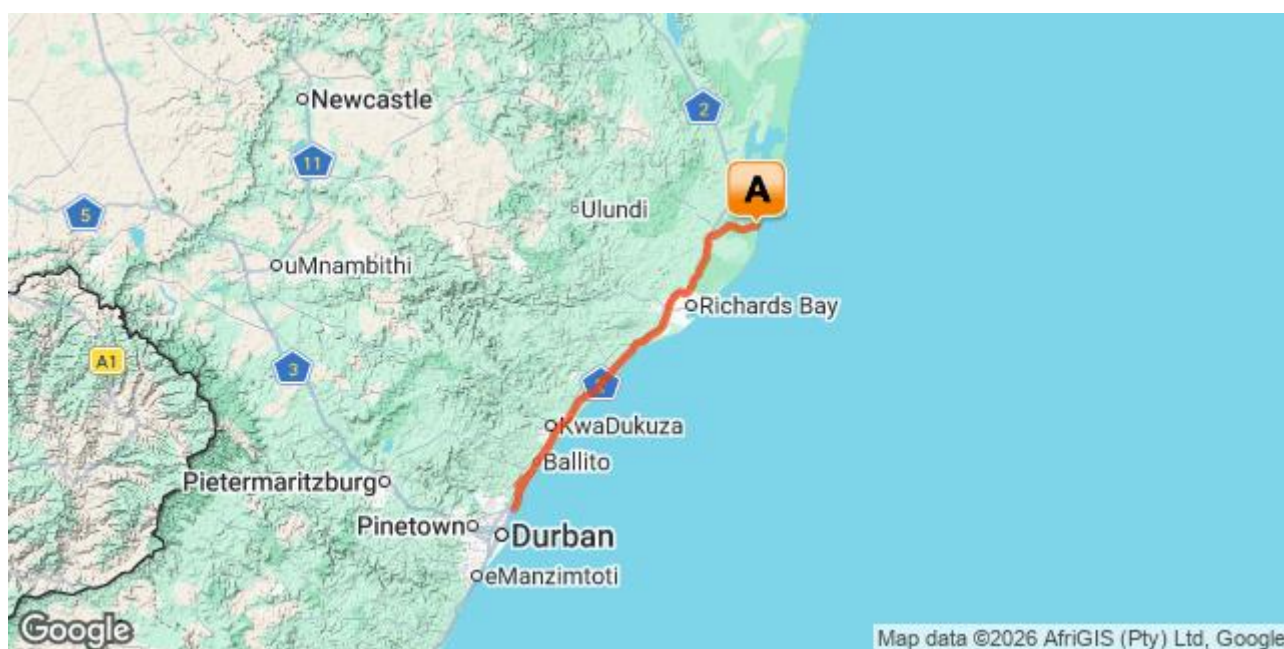

PASSPORT & ENTRY REQUIRMENTS

1. **Validity:** Each traveller's passport must be valid for a minimum of six months beyond your intended departure date. Should your passport have an expiry date of less than 6 months you could be denied entry into the country.
2. **Blank visa pages:** In addition to the above, each country you visit generally requires at least two consecutive blank pages on entry for both visas and stamps, please ensure you have sufficient blank pages in your passport. Should you have insufficient blank pages in your passport then entry or exit from a country could be denied.
3. **Tourist visas:** Please check for each country you visit well in advance if you are required to apply for a tourist visa prior to entry, and any cost related to such tourist visa.

HEALTH & MEDICAL INFORMATION

1. **Personal medication:** Please bring your own personal chronic medication for the duration of your holiday. Also pack general items such as headache tablets, anti-inflammatories, a broad-spectrum antibiotic, motion sickness tablets, anti-allergy medication, antihistamine cream and/or tablets, and a mosquito repellent spray or cream.
2. **Vaccinations:** Please check with your local travel clinic well before travel if you require any vaccinations (such as Yellow Fever) to enter the countries in your itinerary.
3. **Malaria:** Certain parts of Africa are classified as malaria areas, ranging for low risk to high risk. Please discuss the option of malaria prophylactics with your doctor or a consultant at your local travel clinic. Prevent getting bitten by wearing long sleeve tops and trousers in the evenings, using a mosquito repellent spray or cream, and sleeping either under a mosquito net or with a fan/ air-conditioning.

ESSENTIALS ON SAFARI

1. **Wildlife viewing:** Bring a pair of good binoculars per adult traveller. If you are bringing a camera, remember to bring sufficient memory cards, digital storage facility, the battery charger and manual.
2. **Sun protection:** pack a cap, a peak or a wide brimmed hat, sunblock, and decent sunglasses.
3. **Wardrobe:** a couple of neutral-toned items will be useful, but there's no need to go overboard. A good pair of walking shoes is also advisable. As temperatures in the bush can change drastically, bring items that you can layer. In winter (June - August), a beanie, pair of gloves and a scarf are recommended.

LUGGAGE

1. **Allowance:** Please check the luggage allowance on your international and local flights. Our tip is to pack light. Most lodges, hotels and guest houses offer a laundry service, some complimentary and some at an additional charge. The less you take, the less time you spend unpacking and looking for things!
2. **Luggage type:** Soft sided travel bags are required if you are flying on a smaller shuttle flight on safari. In any case, soft sided bags are also recommended when self-driving, for ease of fitting luggage into your rental vehicles. Hard suitcases are often problematic to fit into the boot of a small size rental vehicle and having luggage on the back seat is not advisable.
3. **Excess luggage and special equipment:** For transfers and car rental, we work on standard luggage per person of 1 normal size suitcase and 1 piece of hand luggage. If you are travelling with more luggage, sports equipment, professional filming and photography equipment, or oversized bags, please notify us well in advance.

USING A CREDIT CARD ABROAD

1. **Use abroad:** Please notify your bank that you will be travelling to authorise use of your credit card abroad. Banks can be overly efficient and block your card in case of a transaction that does not meet your normal spending profile.
2. **Use for purchases:** Most hotels, lodges and shops in Africa will accept credit cards. Visa & Mastercard are widely accepted, AMEX and Diners less so.
3. **ATMs** are available at airports, in cities and in most towns and will dispense in local currency.

INTERNET AVAILABILITY

1. **Wi-Fi** is available at most lodges, hotels and guest houses, some with limited speed or only in public areas. Many shopping malls, restaurants and coffee shops also offer free Wi-Fi, but some networks are not secure.
2. **E-Sim:** To make calls via a mobile network and internet access outside Wi-Fi areas, we recommend loading an e-SIM onto your phone for the specific country you are travelling to. If your phone does not support an e-SIM, you can purchase a local SIM card at most international airports, pre-loaded with data. You will find 4G networks in most urban areas. Less so in the wilderness.

Itinerary Terms and Conditions

GET AFRICA TRAVEL TERMS & CONDITIONS – DIRECT

1. DEFINITIONS

In these Terms & Conditions, unless inconsistent with the context, the following words and expressions shall bear the meanings assigned thereto and cognate words and expressions shall bear the corresponding meaning:

- **Get Africa Travel**: **Paton's Places c.c. Trading as Get Africa Travel**, with registered address 53 Chelsea Drive, Durban North, 4051, South Africa, and duly registered in terms of the laws of the Republic of South Africa with company registration number 95/034332/23.
- **Traveller**: Any natural person, either jointly or severally, who enquires about specific Travel Services and/or books such Travel Services directly with Get Africa Travel and for who the Travel Services have been arranged by Get Africa Travel.
- **Travel Services**: travel arrangements, including those supplied by third-party service providers and suppliers, including but not limited to accommodation, car hire, transfers, private guiding, meet & greet services, excursions, activities, conferences, events, and flights.
- **Final Offer**: the quotation and itinerary for Travel Services prepared by Get Africa Travel for the Traveller and accepted by the Traveller.
- **Business Day**: Monday to Friday, excluding gazetted South African public holidays and whenever any gazetted South African public holiday falls on a Sunday, the following Monday (<https://www.gov.za/about-sa/public-holidays>).

2. PREAMBLE

- 2.1. Get Africa Travel is a professional tour operator arranging Travel Services for and on behalf of Travellers in Africa. Get Africa Travel acts for itself and on behalf of its third-party suppliers which are governed by rules and regulations stipulated in their respective country of operation.

- 2.2. Get Africa Travel is a member of SATSA (<https://www.satsa.com/>), ensuring that the company adheres to a strict Code of Conduct. SATSA Members are bonded with third-party indemnity, ensuring financially sound relationships when using them as suppliers. All SATSA members:
- Have integrity: adhere to a strict code of conduct;
 - Are legitimate: company registration is checked annually, and assurance provided that they are legally allowed to use their trading name;
 - Are financially stable: solvency checks are conducted annually;
 - Are legally compliant: in accordance with regulations governing the tourism industry;
 - Are insured: appropriate insurance cover with minimum indemnity limits;
 - Are bonded: the Traveller's pre-tour deposits are guaranteed;
- SATSA Terms & Conditions apply.

3. PERTINENCE

These Terms & Conditions apply to all enquiries for and bookings of Travel Services by a Traveller directly with Get Africa Travel. These General Terms & Conditions do not apply to agent bookings. Only if Get Africa Travel has agreed to conditions that divert from the below explicitly in writing, such explicit conditions will prevail. It is the responsibility of the Traveller to ensure that all persons travelling together with the Traveller are aware that these Terms & Conditions apply to their Travel Services and Final Offer.

BOOKING PROCEDURE

- 3.1. Any provisional bookings for Travel Services are held for a limited period, usually between 7-14 days, depending on the supplier. Thereafter Travel Services will become subject to availability.
- 3.2. Prior to acceptance of an offer, the Traveller will review the details of each travel segment of the itinerary for accuracy, and inform Get Africa Travel of any discrepancies, errors or services that the Traveller wishes to omit or add.
- 3.3. On acceptance of the Final Offer, the Traveller must confirm the itinerary in writing to Get Africa Travel by return email to the address from which the offer was received. Simultaneously, the Traveller must provide Get Africa Travel with a copy of the valid passport of each traveller, clearly showing the relevant information: full names, nationality, passport numbers, date of birth.
- 3.4. Prior to confirmation of an itinerary, prices may be subject to change and services subject to availability.
- 3.5. Once an itinerary is confirmed, prices may remain subject to change due to government increases (park fees, taxes), fuel increases, rate of exchange fluctuations, and other increases beyond Get Africa Travel's control. In such event, Get Africa Travel will do its utmost to minimize the disruption of the itinerary and additional charges, however any costs incurred in relation thereto will be borne by the Traveller.

4. AMENDMENTS TO CONFIRMED BOOKINGS

- 4.1. Any changes to the Final Offer by the Traveller will incur a change fee, which will be determined by Get Africa Travel depending on the type of itinerary and type of amendment.
- 4.2. Get Africa Travel reserves the right to change the itinerary, transport and accommodation of a Final Offer if conditions such as fire, natural disasters, third-party supplier circumstances, etcetera force such a change.
- 4.3. Get Africa Travel reserves the right to increase the price of the Final Offer up to 20 days prior to the departure date of the trip, and up to a maximum of eight percent (8%) of the total price for the following valid reasons:
 - 4.3.1. Changes in the price of fuel or other energy sources for passenger transport;
 - 4.3.2. Taxes or fees (e.g., airport taxes, national park fees, VAT);
 - 4.3.3. Exchange rates relevant to the trip.

5. INVOICING & TERMS OF PAYMENT

- 5.1. The Final Offer will be invoiced once Get Africa Travel has received confirmation from all relevant third-party suppliers, such as hotels, lodges, and other service providers.
- 5.2. In general, itineraries are invoiced and payable in South African Rand for services in South Africa and Namibia, and in United States Dollars for services in other parts of Southern Africa, East Africa and the

Indian Ocean Islands. If agreed between parties, Get Africa Travel will invoice itineraries in an alternative currency as appropriate.

- 5.3. The Payment terms below apply to the total price of the Travel Services, except for flight tickets which are payable in full on issue, and if a third-party supplier stipulates stricter payment terms.
 - 5.3.1. For Travel Services confirmed and invoiced by Get Africa Travel at more than 90 days prior to travel:
 - 25% non-refundable deposit payment is required on confirmation of booking and payable within 7 days of receipt of the Get Africa Travel invoice.
 - 75% balance payment must be received by Get Africa Travel no later than 45 days prior to the departure date of the itinerary.
 - If a Traveller wishes to pay the balance earlier than 45 days prior to the departure date of the itinerary to benefit from a favourable exchange rate, Get Africa Travel will invoice the balance accordingly and payment must be remitted by the Traveller the same day.
 - 5.3.2. For Travel Services confirmed and invoiced at 90 days or less prior to travel, the Get Africa Travel invoice is payable in full within 7 days of receipt thereof.
- 5.4. Proof of payment must be sent to booking@getafricatravel.com.
- 5.5. Late payment may result in release of services.
- 5.6. Any amendments after confirmation and invoicing may require an additional deposit payment.
- 5.7. Any waiver of deposit payment or diversion of the terms of payment does not waive cancellation policies relevant to the itinerary.
- 5.8. It is the Traveller's responsibility to ensure that the banking details provided for a deposit or balance payment are correct. Banking details can be verified telephonically with Get Africa Travel on +27 31 563 9078.

6. PAYMENT VIA CREDIT CARD

- 6.1. Payment by credit card will incur a transactional surcharge of maximum 3.5%, depending on the card type used to process payment.

7. CANCELLATIONS

- 7.1. The cancellation terms below apply to the total booking price.
- 7.2. Cancellation of any service booked with Get Africa Travel must be communicated in writing via email to info@getafricatravel.com. Communications received on a Business Day between 00h00 and 16h00 South African time will be considered to have been received on that day. Communications received outside these times, will be considered to have been received the following Business Day.
- 7.3. This cancellation policy applies to all reservations, except for airline tickets which have individual cancellation policies. This cancellation policy applies regardless of whether payment to the value of the cancellation fee has been received.
 - 7.3.1. 25% cancellation fee: 61+ days before departure of trip
 - 7.3.2. 50% cancellation fee: 60-46 days before departure of trip
 - 7.3.3. 100% cancellation fee: 45 days or less before departure of trip
 - 7.3.4. No refunds are offered for missed excursions, activities, no-shows, early check-outs.
- 7.4. Stricter policies may be imposed by a supplier to Get Africa Travel, which will apply to the Traveller. In that case, Get Africa Travel will inform the Traveller and do its utmost to minimise an increase in cancellation fees.
- 7.5. In the event a refund is due, all banking charges will be for the account of the Traveller.

8. RESPONSIBILITY OF THE TRAVELLER

- 8.1. It is the responsibility of the Traveller to take out adequate travel insurance when Get Africa Travel issues the invoice for the Final Offer. Comprehensive travel insurance is essential for every Traveller's protection against cost of cancellations by the Traveller, Get Africa Travel, or a third-party supplier for unforeseeable circumstances. If a Traveller has chosen not to take out insurance or has taken out inadequate insurance, Get Africa Travel is under no obligation to negotiate any refund or credit on behalf of the Traveller.
- 8.2. Passports must be valid for at least 6 months beyond the intended departure date of travel and have at least 2 consecutive blank visa pages per country included in the Travel Services. If these requirements are not met, the Traveller could be denied entry or exit at time of travel.

- 8.3. Compliance with any visa requirements and all costs related to visas are the responsibility of the Traveller.
- 8.4. The Traveller must carry proof of relevant inoculations as required by the countries included in the Travel Services and ensure that he/ she/ they is/ are medically fit to travel.
- 8.5. It is the responsibility of the Traveller to familiarise himself/ herself / themselves and comply with luggage limitations and specifications for air travel and the luggage capacity of any car rental group booked. Road transfer arrangements are booked based on Travellers travelling with one (1) suitcase and up to two (2) pieces of hand luggage. In the event that Travellers will be travelling with additional luggage, this must be communicated to Get Africa Travel prior to travel. Additional charges for increased luggage capacity may apply.

9. PERSONAL INFORMATION

Get Africa Travel will never sell or pass on your personal or sensitive information. Personal information will be distributed to the accommodation, car rental companies and other service providers relevant to the itinerary of the Traveller who require such details for the itinerary to be completed. Personal information will remain on file with Get Africa Travel after the itinerary has ended, unless an instruction to delete any such information has been received by Get Africa Travel from the Traveller.

10. MARKETING

Get Africa Travel registers the email address of each Traveller. If a Traveller does not wish to receive marketing material distributed by Get Africa Travel via email, an email can be sent to info@getafricatravel.com to stop receiving such emails. The recipient of a newsletter from Get Africa Travel can at any time click on the unsubscribe option to stop receiving email newsletters and other marketing communiques.

11. AMENDMENTS TO TERMS & CONDITIONS

Get Africa Travel reserves the right to amend its terms and conditions at any time. Confirmed itineraries will not be affected by such amendments unless there are obstacles beyond Get Africa Travel's control.

12. FORCE MAJEURE

Get Africa Travel does not accept liability or pay any compensation, interest or damages to the Traveller where the performance or prompt performance of Get Africa Travel's obligations is prevented or affected by force majeure, or if the Traveller has suffered any damage, loss or expense of any nature as a result of force majeure.

13. COMPLAINTS, DISPUTES & APPLICABLE LAW

- 13.1. Any complaints related to Travel Services must be telephonically reported to Get Africa Travel at the time of the incident and followed up in writing via email to info@getafricatravel.com no later than 30 days after the incident has occurred.
- 13.2. Get Africa Travel will acknowledge the complaint and endeavor to investigate it with the relevant service provider within a 30 day period after which it will provide you with written feedback.
- 13.3. Although Get Africa Travel will make every effort to assist in the resolution of the complaint, it cannot guarantee the satisfactory resolution of complaints for services and products outside of its control and for which it is not responsible.
- 13.4. The Travel Services and these Terms & Conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with South African law and any disputes in relation thereto that cannot be resolved between parties will be brought to the competent court in South Africa.
